In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. The VHOC reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against the VHOC or any official thereof.

All dogs must be on leash at all times when on trial grounds except when in the designated warm-up area or competing on the course.

REFUNDS

Full Entry fees will be refunded if an entry is pulled before the closing date/ time. . Duplicate entries will be fully refunded.

Bitches in season are not permitted to compete in Agility Trials. Bitches in season are not allowed on the show grounds. As such, the club will issue full refund if the Trial Secretary receives WRITTEN notice of withdrawal no later than 1/2 hour prior to the start of the first class of the day of the trial.

Change of judge, after the distribution of the premium list if the judging assignment changes the exhibitor has the right to request a full refund of their entry fees for any class affected. Exhibitors must submit requests in writing to the Trial Secretary a minimum of 30 minutes preceding the start of the event on the first day the exhibitor is entered.

Refunds for injured dogs or handlers: 50% refund will be given for a dog or handler that has a note from their vet or doctor saying they cannot participate in the show. The doctor's note must be prior to show date.

<u>Directions to Vet</u>: Turn Right out of the park onto Woodley Ave. Turn Left on Victory Blvd. Take Victory Blvd to Reseda Blvd. Turn Right on Reseda Blvd. Turn Right on Hart for the parking lot.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendations to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

MEASURING & JUMP HEIGHT CARD INFORMATION

Effective January 1, 2010, exhibitors are no longer required to provide proof to Trial Secretaries that their dog has a valid jump height card as part of the check-in process. Furthermore, this change eliminates the need for a copy of the jump height card to be submitted with an entry form. Dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form may still compete; but they must be measured by the Judge of Record PRIOR to running in their class and this measurement will be valid for that weekend of trials only. The exception to this requirement is a dog entered in

the 24" or 26" height division. However, if a Volunteer Measuring Official (VMO) or an Agility Field Rep is present; ALL dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form must be measured at some time during the trial or cluster of trials. This does not preclude having the dog wicketed by the Judge of Record if the VMO or Rep is not available to measure the dog before its first run of the trial or cluster of trials. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running and failure to do so will result in the cancellation of any qualifying scores.

MOVE-UPS

All pre-show move ups must be received by 6 pm on the Monday before the trial. The AKC requires move-ups to be in writing. You may send an email for a move-up to Iribbeck91@gmail.com with your name, your dog's call name, the name & date of the trial and what class you want the dog to be moved to.

Day to Day Move-ups will be allowed. The request for moving up must be made in writing at the trial site to the Trial Secretary not later than the day preceding the event provided the Trial Secretary receives them by the end of the trial day. Day-to-day move-ups may not be requested via the phone or by email. It is permissible for an exhibitor to request a day-to-day move-up in person for the following day on a trial day of which he/she did not show their dog. The exhibitor may have someone else on-site fill out/sign the form as their representative.

There will be **no move-ups in the morning before the start of the trial**; however, a dog which has been entered in a Novice "A" class for which it is not eligible to be entered in due to class restrictions on the dog or handler may be moved to the Novice "B" class under the following conditions: The request for the move must be in writing and presented to the superintendent or trial secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of each trial. The request must state the reason and justification for the move from a Novice"A" class to the Novice "B" class.

After close of entries a dog may be moved down in their class level (i.e. Master to Excellent). The request for the move to the class for which the dog is eligible must be in writing and submitted to the superintendent or trial secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of the trial

RIBBONS, AWARDS, AND PRIZES

Rosettes will be awarded in each jump height division in each class as follows: First Place – Blue, Second Place – Red, Third Place – Yellow, Fourth Place – White A New Title rosette will be awarded to all dog and handler teams finishing a title, while quantities are available. A MACH rosette will be awarded to all dog and handler teams that attain their MACH. A PACH rosette will be awarded to all dog and handler teams that attain their PACH title. A flat green ribbon will be awarded to all dogs that earn a qualifying score.

If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.
