Pet Emergency Wallet Card

What a great idea for a pet owner! A Pet Emergency Wallet Card or My Pet Is Home Alone Card is something that every pet owner should consider. It is very easy to make and comes really helpful for your loved pets in emergent situations.



The pet emergency wallet card can be easily do it yourself.

Just get a piece of card or stock paper about the size of a name card. It should prominently declares that your cat or dog is alone at home on one side. On the other side, you can put down more detailed information for how to help your pet, such as descriptions about your pets and information of an emergency contact.

The front side will look something similar to the example to the left, and the back side will look like the below example given by Ventura County Animal Services.

Cancerous Conditions
Lymphosarcoma or Lymphoma
Skin Cancer (Malignant Skin Neoplasia)
Splenic (Spleen) Cancer
Bone or Joint Cancer
Hepatic (Liver) Cancer
Thoracic (Chest) Cancer
Bladder Cancer
Brain or Spinal Cord Cancer
Oral Cancer or Malignant Oral Neoplasia
Anal Gland Cancer

National Pet Cancer Awarenes Month - continued

Spot the Early Warning Signs of Pet Cancer

Cancer is the #1 disease related killer of pets. Please protect your pet with regular veterinary examinations and by being on the lookout for any early warning signs.

The most prevalent signs according to the American Veterinary Medical Association are:

- Abnormal swellings that persist or continue to grow
- Sores that do not heal
- Weight loss
- Loss of appetite
- Bleeding or discharge from any body opening
- Offensive odor
- Difficulty eating or swallowing
- Hesitation to exercise or loss of stamina
- Persistent lameness or stiffness
- Difficulty breathing, urinating or defecating.

If you notice any of the above signs in your dog or cat contact your veterinarian. While these signs are also present with other illnesses or injuries it is always best to check with your veterinarian.
